Des Moines International Airport (DSM) officials have been notified by Delta representatives that the airline will re-introduce non-stop service to Salt Lake City (SLC) on June 4. The daily service will use a 50-seat Regional Jet. It will depart DSM at 6:20 am and arrive at SLC at 8:10am. It will depart SLC at 5:00pm and land at DSM at 7:30.

“This is more great news for central Iowans,” states Airport Spokesperson Roy Criss. “This was a popular service in the past. Add this to Allegiant’s recent new destination announcement and the fact that we gained back 730 daily seats of capacity the last two months, and we see our partner carriers showing confidence in our market during difficult times. We truly appreciate Delta bringing back this service to the west and at times that work well for central Iowans.”

This brings the total number of non-stop destinations out of DSM back to 18. On February 18 that number will be 19. Daily seat capacity at DSM is now close to 9,000.
