As part of the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration of the Des Moines International Airport (DSM), airport officials are inviting the public to an Open House and Aircraft Display. In partnership with the Iowa Aviation Promotion Group (IAPG), this will also be its annual *Fly Iowa* event.

The Open House and Fly Iowa event will feature displays of vintage and modern aircraft, aviation-related vendors, military aircraft (with possible fly-bys) and educational activities. There will also be food and gift services available. The event kicks off with a fly-in/drive-in pancake breakfast at Signature Flight Support from 7:00-10:30. Pilots in command eat free. Tickets are \$4 for adults and \$2 for kids under 12.

The first plane to land at DSM in 1932 will be on display. It is a Waco bi-plane owned by the Meredith family. Katy Meredith has graciously offered it for the day before she donates it to the Aviation Museum in Oshkosh, WI.
